Class of 2022 grads reap the rewards of hard work

Like previous classes, two-thirds of HighSight's Class of 2022 were testing below the 65th percentile when entering the program after middle school. But through hard work and the guidance and support of HighSight staff and tutors, they have gone on to achieve some amazing things:

- They had a group 3.84 GPA, more than 25% higher than their classmates;
- Like the classes before them, 100% received at least a full-tuition scholarship;
- All are headed to colleges in the top 20% nationally.


